ANDREA ODEZYNSKA, an independent filmmaker, was born in Philadelphia, PA. While growing up within the Ukrainian American Diaspora community of Philadelphia, Andrea had the good fortune to study and perform with "Voloshky" a Ukrainian Dance Ensemble. "Voloshky" instilled in her a love of the performing arts. She holds a B.A. in Theater from Bennington College in Vermont and an MFA from The American Film Institute in Los Angeles where she studied Directing. After receiving her MFA in Los Angeles, Andrea worked for Quentin Tarantino's production company, A Band Apart. There she assisted Ukrainian American Producer, Michael Bodnarchek. Michael ran the music video and television commercial wing of A Band Apart. Andrea returned to New York, where she continued to make her own grant driven independent films. Andrea has taught filmmaking for SVA (School of Visual Arts) and NYU Tisch School of the Arts. Recently, she completed a new feature length documentary film and is running filmmaking workshops for Princeton University.

VIRLANA TKACZ heads the Yara Arts Group and has directed over thirty five original shows at La MaMa Theatre in New York, as well as in Kyiv, Lviv, Kharkiv, Bishkek, Ulaanbaatar, and Ulan Ude. She has co-produced a series of recordings of Buryat Mongolian artists and of the Koliadnyky of Kryvorivnia from the Carpathian Mountains. Last year she initiated Yara's Ukrainian Culture in America Series, as well as the Yara World Music Festival as very successful virtual events.

**WALDEMART KLYUZKO** is an artist from Kyiv who has collaborated with Yara Arts Group since 2010, most recently creating the set for *Opera GAZ*. He is a visual artist who has had exhibits at La MaMa Galleria, the Ukrainian Institute of America and the Bezpala Gallery in Toronto.

**DARIEN FIORINO** is in a masters program at Harvard University. He was in Yara's *Winter Songs on Mars*, 1917/2017: Tychyna, Zhadan, and the Dogs at La MaMa and A Thousand Suns at La Plaza Cultural this summer
